
YEAR IN REVIEW

Total Number of Mentees (New registrants)



MATCH RATIO


Match Ratio Compared to Benchmarked Universities

MENTEE GOAL ACHIEVEMENT

97% of mentees reported that they felt the University supported them in developing their personal and professional network with UGA alumni & friends.

97% of mentees reported gaining an appreciation for mentoring as a personal and professional development tool.

94% of mentees reported that the University provided them with an avenue to explore career interests and professional goals.


