



Hi @Vish, a student's eligibility for aid is based on info submitted on the FAFSA or California Dream Act Application. An increase in eligibility would depend on a variety of personal factors and the best way to explore your specific situation is to contact us by phone or via Contact An Expert. In the meantime, you can look at a couple of areas online to better educate yourself and your family on these options. One is a Family Contribution appeal - to be submitted if your financial info differs from what was submitted on the FAFSA or CADAA; the other is a Cost of Attendance Appeal, which looks at additional costs and loan options to cover them.
