This fall, Sabah Sial, BS '22 begins a new chapter at the University of Oxford, where she is studying finance. Sial is the recipient of a Rhodes Scholarship, one of 32 awardees out of 2,300 students who applied. The last student from the University of Utah to receive the prestigious award was in 2002.

"Being a Rhodes Scholar is a great honor, but it wouldn't have been possible without the scholarships that preceded it," Sial said. "The University of Utah, its faculty, and my fellow students helped me to find my voice."

Born in Pakistan, Sial's family emigrated to Sandy, Utah, where she spent most of her childhood. In her application to the Rhodes scholarship, Sial recounted one fateful morning in 2015. As she walked into her high school, three young men jumped out of a Jeep and confronted her, shouting derogatory slurs about her hijab, the scarf she wears as an expression of her Muslim faith.

Sial had faced similar slurs before, but she also noticed a fellow classmate, who remained silent. "I don't blame him, because at that age, you really don't know how to respond," Sial said.

In the years that followed, the silence stayed with Sial, and to this day motivates her. "I believe that we can break that cycle of silence. I want to do better. I want to show others that we can do better."
